1. James Bert Hayward, Past Camp Commander of Winfield Scott Whitehurst Camp 1, and as such founding Camp Commander in the creation of the Department of Florida, answered final muster May 5, 2013.
2. Department of Florida Brothers will be in mourning through June 4, 2013. This includes affixing mourning ribbons on membership badges, draping charters at meetings, and affixing the mourning cords on flags and swords.
3. Visitation will be at 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm Friday, May 10, 2013 at Stowers Funeral Home, 401 West Brandon Boulevard, Brandon. A funeral will be conducted at 11:00 am at the same location, with interment immediately following at Oaklawn Cemetery, Plant City.
4. Brother Hayward's obituary was published in "The Tampa Tribune" (tbo.com) on May 8, 2013. Brother Hayward served in the 11<sup>th</sup> Airborne Division, United States Army during the Korean Conflict, and later served in the Air Force and Army Reserves, and the National Guard in Florida.
5. Born November 15, 1930 in Plant City, Florida, Brother Hayward was great-grandson of Jane and Jeremiah Kelly of Company E, Missouri Home Guard (US) during the Civil War. He was awarded an Associate of Arts degree by Florida Central College. A member of Saint Stephens Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus, he was a past president of the East Hillsborough Historical Society. He was a member of the Society of Colonial Wars in the State of Florida, the Sons of the American Revolution, the Society of the War of 1812, a number of SCV organizations, and the Order of Kentucky Colonels. He was a Mason and a Shriner.
